

The late Eva Smith

Eva born in 1930, was brought up on Berry Farm, Scalloway and had a great passion for farm life at both their Berry Farm and their farm at Pitmeden, Aberdeenshire. Alongside her brother, the late Jim Smith they also took over the running of the family business Jamieson & Smith Wool Brokers following the passing of their father and the company's founder, the late John Smith.

Eva alongside her late brother Jim ran the Berry Shetland Pony Stud. The Berry Stud is known and respected worldwide for quality miniature and standard ponies. Berry bloodlines trace far back in the stud books and can be found in ponies pedigrees the world over.



Eva was a keen horsewoman from a young age, having several bigger horses throughout the years alongside the Shetland Pony Stud. She was a great supporter of the Pony Breeders of Shetland Association and stewarded annually for years at the Pony Sale, up until she retired just a few years ago.

Eva was a well respected judge, and at 17 became the youngest judge of her era to judge at the prestigious Royal Highland Show. Eva's passion for the standard pony remained strong throughout, with Jim's preference to the miniatures. 2017 saw Eva's homebred mare 'Willow of Berry' achieve the

highest score since the evaluations started in 2006 at the Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme with 92%. Many of the Berry ponies achieved Gold Awards at the Shetland Pony Evaluations including 'Rum of Berry', 'Watzo of Berry' and 'Zorti of Berry'. Eva and Jim's ponies were regular prize winners in the showring, including Supreme Champion at the Millennium Show, Supreme Champion at the Viking show in 2010 and Miniature Ring Champion in 2012 to name just a few.

Eva was a stalwart for the Shetland Pony, always keen to share her knowledge with those who asked. She will be hugely missed by all who knew her, and by the Shetland Pony World as a whole.

Select Sale of Ponies – Promoting the Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme

The Shetland Pony Breed Show is due to be held in Shetland in 2019. We hope to create a full week celebrating the Shetland Pony in its homeland. The Evaluations are to be held the weekend prior to the Breed Show 20th & 21st July 2019. The week will be filled with various areas having studs available for visitors, with the ISPC meeting on Friday 26th July, Breed Show to be held at Clickimin on Saturday 27th July and the Select Sale of ponies to be held on Sunday 28th July.

A Select Sale is planned and will consist of hopefully around 20-30 ponies, which have been through the evaluations/are out of evaluated parents/grandparents. We aim to promote evaluated stock by having a parade of evaluated ponies prior to the sale. We hope to attract ponies which would rarely be offered for sale in an auction environment, thus creating a sale of premium ponies. With an international audience in attendance; we want to take this opportunity to showcase our evaluation and the ponies produced as a result of the evaluations. The sale is to be held at Shetland Rural Centre, with auctioneer Rod Mackenzie in attendance. Ibidder facilities will hopefully also be available, further attracting a wider audience. This is the ideal opportunity to showcase our evaluation scheme, and promote ponies from the scheme to a wide audience.


For ponies to be considered for inclusion, they must be by a sire who has either gone through the Old Assessment system (pre 2006) or have been through the Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme. The assessments in 2018 will be the last opportunity to have ponies evaluated and as such eligible to be considered for inclusion in this sale.

Closing date for entries for 2018 SPES is 30th June.

Breed Show 2019 – Stud Visits


