



SPES Select Sale Information and Requirements for Entry

As part of the 2019 Breed Show Celebrations, the PBSA are hosting a Select Sale of ponies, which will be held on Sunday 28th July 2019, with auctioneer Rod Mackenzie and IBidder facilities available. The aim is to showcase the quality of stock Shetland has to offer and to promote the Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme. It is proposed that approximately 30 ponies will be selected for sale and it is hoped a good range of ponies with differing blood lines, colour, height, age and sex will be forward; most of which would not normally be offered for sale in an auction environment. There is already a lot of interest in this sale from prospective buyers from the UK, Europe and beyond; harnessing the opportunity of selling premium stock whilst an international audience are in attendance.

This sale is open to entries from PBSA Members only. Ponies entered for sale which have not been seen in the show ring or been evaluated will be viewed prior to acceptance. Immediately prior to the sale there will be a parade of the ponies forward for sale, giving vendors the opportunity to show the pony to potential buyers. Please note that vendors must be willing to keep ponies until October for shipping, if the purchaser requests this.

The committee would like to encourage ponies with a connection to the Evaluations to come forward for entry.

It must be noted all ponies entered may not be accepted for sale depending on the number of entries

See below the requirements for the pony to be eligible for entry

Minimum Entry Requirements



Pony entered to select sale

Filly 3 years and under/Colt under 3 years – Not Evaluated
Or
Mare 4 years and over/Stallion over 3 years – Not Evaluated



Sire/Dam of pony entered for sale

At least one Parent must have been Evaluated through the SPES

Desirable Entry Requirements



Pony entered to select sale

Mare 4yrs and over/Stallion 3yrs and over – Successfully Evaluated through SPES
or
Filly 3 years and under/colt under 3 years – not yet evaluated



Sire and Dam of pony entered for sale

Both Parents successfully Evaluated through SPES

Tracing back to SPSBS Inspected stock (pre 2006)

Any pony with a connection to the Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme will be considered for selection
